The Lea Valley Walk commences on Tuesday 28th February when we embark upon the 50 miles to Leagrave in Luton where the river rises and journeys on to East India Dock where it joins the Thames.

As in the earlier long distance paths that we have completed, the start time is 10.30 am, stop for a coffee break and take time to look at specific places of interest along the way. There shall be an optional lunch at the end of the walk before heading home.

The pace is leisurely and distances range from 6-9 miles depending upon public transport facilities. The following walks have been scheduled for every third Tuesday and hope to complete by the end of July.
